



### FIRST NIGHT OF CLASS

#### What needs to be done?

For the Sunday class you must complete at least the first chapter in your text book, do the work sheet at the end of the chapter, and view the first section of the DVD. Please note, the work sheet is the last page of each chapter. We highly recommended that you do more textbook work than just the one chapter. Each class meeting will cover another chapter in your text book.

You will also need to prepare your mask, as described in the first chapter of your textbook. We also recommend mask defog.

#### Where is the pool?

The Sunday classes are held at Ralston High School pool. First where is Ralston High School? RHS is located at 90th and Park Drive in Ralston. Park Drive is the first street south of Q on 84th Street. Turning right, if coming from the North, or left if coming from the South. As you come to the High School from the east, turn into the first drive (left). As you follow the drive, you will find yourself heading towards the main building. Turn left, as soon as possible, at the service drive. This will take you down towards the tennis courts. The pool double doors are straight ahead, just past the tennis courts. You may park in the small parking lot to your right. Get there a little before your class start time.

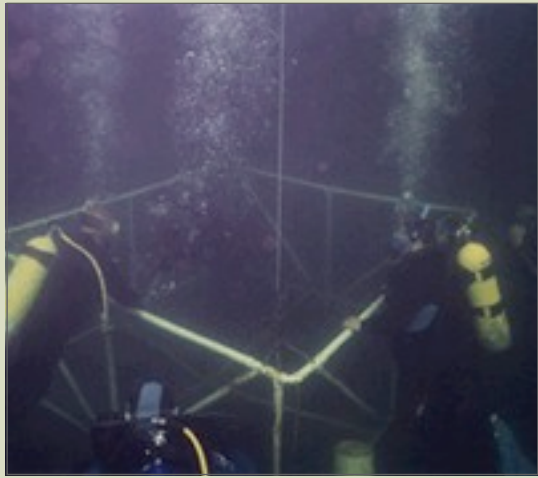
### BOY SCOUTS OPEN WATER DIVER

## OPEN WATER DIVES (PHASE TWO)

To earn your PADI certification, you must complete the open water training dives. Our local dive site is excellent, just 36 miles southeast of Omaha near Malvern, IA. We conduct our Open Water Dives from late April (weather permitting) to the end of October. Open Waters are conducted over the weekends and take two days to complete. During that time, you'll be doing 4 dives. We will furnish all equipment except what is required for the open water course. You have up to 6 months to do your open water dives, one year with a refresher. Beyond a year a mandatory pool dive with skill evaluation is required before you open water dives.

Open waters may be conducted on any of our dive trips that we conduct throughout the year.

PADI and Underwater World offers a "Student Referral Program". With this program you can take your open water training dives in some exotic place.
